Our BFRA Board has poured much blood, sweat, and tears (okay, maybe not blood but definitely sweat... and tears) over the recent release of Knox County's Phased Re-Opening guidelines and recommendations. We are excited to announce that we will be opening our facilities for the 2020 season in accordance with Knox County Health Department recommendations. This means we will be taking a phased approach to opening our facility. Registration will open Tuesday, May 26, 2020 to Benington-Farrington resident stockholders only. The pool will open for swim on June 1, 2020.

When Knox county enters phase three of reopening, we hope to open memberships to non residents. This will be announced as we receive further information.

We know everyone is looking forward to basking in the sun poolside and we cannot wait to see EVERYone's face there as soon as possible.

Based on county recommendations we have instituted the following procedures and modifications to ensure the safety of our members and staff.

- Members and staff will practice social distancing guidelines of maintaining 6ft apart.
- We will not be allowing guests to attend the pool for the 2020 season.
- We will no be offering nanny passes for the 2020 season
- We will provide limited concessions of prepackaged food and beverages.
- There will be no access to recreational activities other than the pool itself. (ie. No basketball, playground, four square, or tetherball)
- We will not be hosting parties, swim team, or special events.
- We will operate on a 3 shift schedule each day to include 2 deep cleaning sessions.
 - Morning Swim: 10am - 1pm
 - Deep Cleaning: 1pm - 2pm
 - Afternoon Swim: 2pm - 5pm
 - Deep Cleaning: 5pm - 6pm
 - Evening Swim: 6pm - 9pm
- All members will be required to sign a membership document before entering the pool for the first time this season.
- No refunds will be issued for the 2020 season
